HOPE OF FAMILY MIDLINE PROJECT EVALUATION REPORT

This report presents the findings from Baseline and Midline of Hope of Family project Evaluation. Since October 2018, Hope of Family selected around 100 vulnerable families under the assistance of the local leaders of Shyogwe sector for joining Hope of Family project as beneficiaries for the timeline of two years. From November to December 2018, Hope of Family has been conducting the baseline survey on 100 vulnerable families (beneficiaries) living in Kabungo and Nyakabingo villages, Kinini cell, Shyogwe sector, Muhanga district in rural Southern Province of Rwanda where Hope of Family is implementing its project activities. The purpose of that baseline survey was to evaluate the level of families' livelihood and socioeconomic status as well as to determine parent's involvement in their children's education. Moreover, Hope of Family provides to the 100 vulnerable families the support for improving their children's education and family livelihoods. Hope of Family has conducted also Midline project evaluation on 100 families's beneficiaries for evaluating project impact towards enhancing children educational and family livelihoods after 12 months of project activities implementation. The results are presented under project's objectives regarding project achievements. The results show that the average family size was 5 family members, 67 % of heads of families were females and 33 % were males. The student's school performance has been increased at 3% due to Hope of Family project support.
